Kindergarten Teaching Assistant

The Kindergarten Teaching Assistant is employed primarily as an aid in support of the Kindergarten teacher.

Summary of responsibilities:

- Act as the teaching assistant in an Early Primary (kindergarten) class;
- Supervise the class during the teacher's preparation periods;
- Supervise the morning day care program.

Summary of requirements:

- A qualification to teach kindergarten (Erzieher/in) is preferred although not required;
- Previous experience working with kindergarten-age children;
- Fluency in English;
- Suitability for working in a school committed to IB values. Evidence of an ability to work in a flexible manner and with good inter-personal skills.

Further notes:

- This will be a full-time (40 hours per week) contract from August 1, 2018 to July 31, 2019.
