The Substitute Teacher is employed to cover classes in the absence of the teacher, and other equivalent roles.

Summary of responsibilities:

- To cover classes in the absence of the teacher.

Summary of requirements:

- Previous experience working with children; an appropriate qualification is preferred
- Fluency in English;
- Flexibility as regards work times and duties;
- A qualification for working with children in some capacity; the qualification may be in-progress and not yet complete;
- Evidence of an ability to work in a flexible manner and with good inter-personal skills.

Further notes:

- In most cases the substitute teacher will be leading activities previously planned by the standard teacher.
- The position is non-contracted; the teacher is able to submit monthly time-sheets for payment.
- The teacher should live within a reasonable travel distance from the school;
- The position will be reimbursed at Category 2 on the ThIS salary scale (further details are available from the school).
